What is the KidGen Genomics Study?

This research study is looking at ways to help us get better at diagnosing genetic kidney disease in Australian families.


Genomic means looking at a person's DNA and how any changes can cause disease. Usually we use a single blood sample for the testing.

Why have I been selected?

We are trying to understand if there is a genetic cause for your / your child's condition.

What do I need to do?

- 1. If the study team think you/your family would be suitable, your doctor will check you are happy to be contacted by the study team
- 2. Have an appointment with your doctor or Genetic Counsellor—consent to have your sample/s tested
- 3. Have your sample/s taken at a hospital pathology (usually a blood test)
- 4. Wait around 6 months* for the results and follow up from the clinic team
