

# KidGen Genomics STUDY



## What is the KidGen Genomics Study?

This research study is looking at ways to help us get better at diagnosing genetic kidney disease in Australian families.

Genomic means looking at a person's DNA and how any changes can cause disease. Usually we use a single blood sample for the testing.

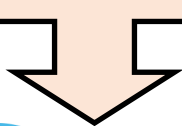
## Why have I been selected?

We are trying to understand if there is a genetic cause for your / your child's condition.

## What do I need to do?

1. If the study team think you/your family would be suitable, your doctor will check you are happy to be contacted by the study team
2. Have an appointment with your doctor or Genetic Counsellor—consent to have your sample/s tested
3. Have your sample/s taken at a hospital pathology (usually a blood test)
4. Wait around 6 months\* for the results and follow up from the clinic team

If you are suitable, you will be contacted by your doctor or by the Genetic Counsellor



You will be sent an info pack including consent forms

## How will I get my results?

The study team will give the results to your doctor and they will talk to you about them. If you would like further information, the Genetic Counsellor from the study team will also be available to talk to you.

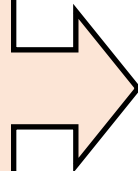
## Will I have to pay?

No—you do not have to pay for the tests involved in this study.

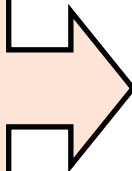
## What if I change my mind?

You can withdraw from the study at any stage. This will not affect your relationship or care from your Renal team.

You will have an opportunity to discuss the study, ask questions and say if you want to take part



Sample is collected and sent to the Laboratory for testing. It can take approx 6 months for a result, sometimes longer



If you require further testing, this may continue throughout the study. If there are any findings, your Dr will report these to you

*\* Result return times may vary, in some instances may take 6-12 months*
